This documentary film tells the story of Nicholas Winton who, together with his team of concerned and dedicated individuals, managed to save 669 endangered children, most of them Jewish, from almost certain death at the hands of Nazis and Nazi collaborators. For 50 years, Winton told no one about his rescue efforts and missions. His wife discovered papers in their attic that related to his prewar activities. From the 669 children he saved, there are more than 5,000 descendants living around the world today.
